CIRCULAR LETTER

TO : ALL AUTHORIZED INSURANCE COMPANIES DOING BUSINESS IN THE PHILIPPINES

SUBJECT : SUBMISSION OF PARTICULARS OF REINSURANCE TREATIES

Section 226 of Republic Act No. 10607 also known as the Insurance Code of the Philippines, as amended, provides that:

"Sec. 226. Every insurance company authorized to do business in the Philippines shall report to the Commissioner on forms prescribed by him the particulars of reinsurance treaties or any new treaties or changes in existing treaties within three (3) months from their effectivity."

In view of the foregoing, all authorized insurance companies doing business in the Philippines are hereby mandated to submit to this Commission the Particulars of Reinsurance Treaty, hereby attached as Annex "A", within three (3) months from the effectivity of any new treaty or changes in the existing treaty.
